

Permanent Handicapped Parking Permit

Issued at no fee to handicapped individuals who have been medically certified with a permanent condition.

Two permits allowed per handicapped individual. Permit is assigned to the individual and can be used in any vehicle when the holder is entering and/or exiting the vehicle.

Permits expire on the individual's birth date, 6 years after issuance.

Temporary Handicapped Parking Permit

Permits expire 6 months after the date of issuance.
