Nebraska Fuel Tax Rate

The second quarter 2016 fuel rate (April 1, 2016 through June 30, 2016) is .2680 cents. The rate for the third quarter 2016 (July 1, 2016 through September 30, 2016) will be .2580 cents.

July 1, 1996 - July 1, 2016: Motor Carrier Services Celebrates 20 years

Do you remember what you were doing 20 years ago? Prince Charles and Princess Diana filed for divorce, everyone was dancing the Macarena and Tickle Me Elmo was the hard to find Christmas gift!

In addition to all that, the Nebraska Motor Carrier Services Division was officially created. The MCS One-Stop-Shop merged programs and people into one division of state government to make it easier to register trucks, obtain IFTA credentials, file quarterly tax returns and file for SSRS or Bingo credentials. The Nebraska Department of Revenue (IFTA), Department of Roads (Conditional Safety Permits) and the Public Service Commission (Bingo/SSRS) transferred eager staff to the Department of Motor Vehicles to begin administering the three programs, making it easier for the trucking industry to conduct business.

Credentialing has changed in 20 years – SSRS and Bingo gave way for the UCR program, IFTA returns and IRP and IFTA renewals no longer need to be filed on paper with the enhancement of our on-line services. The Conditional Safety Permit program is once again administered by the Department of Roads, making it 100 percent on-line.

We look forward to serving the industry for the next 20 years!

When adding a vehicle during the registration year, you can obtain a new set of IFTA decals by accessing our on-line services. Under IFTA Services, click Request Additional Decals and follow the instructions. If the on-line request is received on a holiday or weekend, the decal(s) will be mailed the following business day.

Split Rate - Newfoundland

Newfoundland has a split rate for Gasoline and Diesel. The first line of tax rates on the back of this newsletter is for travel from April 1, 2016 through June 1, 2016. The second line is for travel from June 2, 2016 through June 30, 2016. If you file your return on-line, the process will direct you to the tax rate based on the time frame you choose. If you utilize the paper return, the Diesel-Only return has the two rates displayed. If you use fuel other than diesel and you traveled to Newfoundland during the second quarter, you will write in the miles and gallons according to the tax rate chart. It is important to report your travel and fuel on the appropriate line.
